We provide professional photography experiences at large-scale school events, including portrait studios, red carpet arrivals, social photography, roving photography and on-site printing.

We are looking for photographers who enjoy working with people, thrive in fast-paced environments and want to be part of a professional and supportive team.

### ROLE OVERVIEW

This role involves photographing high school formals and events as part of a team environment. Photographers may be assigned to portrait studio photography, red carpet coverage, social and roving photography or event support roles.

The role suits both experienced event photographers and photographers looking to gain real-world industry experience in live event environments.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

Responsibilities may include:

- Running an on-site portrait studio
- Photographing couples, friendship groups and families
- Capturing car arrivals and red carpet moments
- Shooting roving candid and posed social photography
- Directing individuals and large groups confidently
- Assisting with lighting setup and pack down
- Following event run sheets and team direction
- Maintaining professional presentation and customer service standards throughout the event

### WORK ENVIRONMENT

Events are fast-paced, high-energy environments involving large crowds, are time-sensitive and have ongoing interaction with students, families and event staff.

Photographers are expected to remain calm, organised and professional while working efficiently under pressure.

Most shifts take place Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings, typically commencing around 4pm.

Applicants should:

- Be confident operating DSLR or mirrorless cameras

- Work well within a team environment
- Have exceptional attention to detail
